**Q. We're getting ready for our honeymoon, but it's hand-luggage only. What skincare essentials would you recommend?**

A. When travelling, you're constantly encountering new environments so a simple routine is best. But with just four products you can still keep that new-bride glow going!

Vital to any routine is a good cleanser – this sets you up for every other product applied afterwards. For travel, I'd always recommend an oil cleanser, simply because they do so much. An oil cleanser helps to boost hydration, decongest pores and remove dead skin cells, as well as make-up and pollution – my personal favourite is Cosmedix Purity Solution (£37 for 100ml). You should be using an antioxidant every day (whether travelling or not). The most potent form would be a serum, but if you're short on luggage space, try a moisturiser that also contains an antioxidant. My pick would be Allies of Skin Peptides & Antioxidants Firming Daily Treatment (£98 for 50ml).



Skin repairs itself most while you're asleep, so support it at night with peptides and hyaluronic acid. Peptides are the building blocks of collagen, elastin and keratin – responsible for your skin's texture, strength and resilience. Exuviance Age Reverse Night Lift (£49 for 50ml) contains both.

Finally, sunscreen is essential, whatever the weather! It'll protect from pollution as well as UVA and UVB rays. Avene Mineral Fluid SPF50+ (£17.50 for 40ml) is suitable for sensitive skin, won't cause breakouts and can be picked up at chemists worldwide.
